Jason Smith had a somewhat forgettable career in college radio (meaning he's forgotten most of it), hosting the morning show at the campus station Z-89 while he attended Syracuse University. After graduating and losing his thick New York accent, his theater-of-the-mind career went nowhere. Doing a little bit better in television production, he spent the majority of the 1990's producing various sports shows for ESPN, Fox and ABC. Radio didn't reappear on his horizon until a chance meeting with Rick Dees in Los Angeles got the juices flowing again.

Los Angeles being the 'who you know' town, he got a huge break and started filling in as a sports-talk host on the former AM 1150. An apparent dire need for overnight programming on the weekends led him to a job in L.A. at Fox Sports Radio, where he ascended to weekday latenight co-host and then into afternoon drive co-host on the national network that reached over 125 affiliates. After leaving the network in early 2004, he was both in front of and behind the television camera, featured in Fox Sports Net's long-running series 'The Sports List' and later on 'In Focus'.

It was in the winter of 2004 he began filling in on the ESPN Radio network in various dayparts, eventually hosting a weekend show with Mel Kiper, Jr. in 2005. He was named the new host of "AllNight" in September of that year. Since then, AllNight has grown and now reaches over 500 affiliates coast-to-coast, the most cleared sports-talk show in the country. AllNight airs weeknights from 10pm-2am PDT, and is home to his unique brand of sports-talk combined with lifestyle radio and many, many, many movie references. He also represents ESPN Radio in covering the ESPY's red carpet. In addition to ESPN Radio, Jason has also written for ESPN.com, and appears on ESPN TV. Currently, he's a fill-in host and regular forum guest on "Jim Rome Is Burning" on ESPN. His appearances have also included "ESPN First Take" on ESPN2, and ESPN News.
