### 794.022 Rules of evidence.—

- (1) The testimony of the victim need not be corroborated in a prosecution under s. 794.011.
- (2) Specific instances of prior consensual sexual activity between the victim and any person other than the offender shall not be admitted into evidence in a prosecution under s. <u>794.011</u>. However, such evidence may be admitted if it is first established to the court in a proceeding in camera that such evidence may prove that the defendant was not the source of the semen, pregnancy, injury, or disease; or, when consent by the victim is at issue, such evidence may be admitted if it is first established to the court in a proceeding in camera that such evidence tends to establish a pattern of conduct or behavior on the part of the victim which is so similar to the conduct or behavior in the case that it is relevant to the issue of consent.
- (3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, reputation evidence relating to a victim's prior sexual conduct or evidence presented for the purpose of showing that manner of dress of the victim at the time of the offense incited the sexual battery shall not be admitted into evidence in a prosecution under s. 794.011.
- (4) When consent of the victim is a defense to prosecution under s. <u>794.011</u>, evidence of the victim's mental incapacity or defect is admissible to prove that the consent was not intelligent, knowing, or voluntary; and the court shall instruct the jury accordingly.
- (5) An offender's use of a prophylactic device, or a victim's request that an offender use a prophylactic device, is not, by itself, relevant to either the issue of whether or not the offense was committed or the issue of whether or not the victim consented.

### 794.011 Sexual battery.—

- (1) As used in this chapter:
- (a) "Consent" means intelligent, knowing, and voluntary consent and does not include coerced submission. "Consent" shall not be deemed or construed to mean the failure by the alleged victim to offer physical resistance to the offender.
- (b) "Mentally defective" means a mental disease or defect which renders a person temporarily or permanently incapable of appraising the nature of his or her conduct.
- (c) "Mentally incapacitated" means temporarily incapable of appraising or controlling a person's own conduct due to the influence of a narcotic, anesthetic, or intoxicating substance administered without his or her consent or due to any other act committed upon that person without his or her consent.
- (d) "Offender" means a person accused of a sexual offense in violation of a provision of this chapter.
- (e) "Physically helpless" means unconscious, asleep, or for any other reason physically unable to communicate unwillingness to an act.
- (f) "Retaliation" includes, but is not limited to, threats of future physical punishment, kidnapping, false imprisonment or forcible confinement, or extortion.
- (g) "Serious personal injury" means great bodily harm or pain, permanent disability, or permanent disfigurement.
- (h) "Sexual battery" means oral, anal, or vaginal penetration by, or union with, the sexual organ of another or the anal or vaginal penetration of another by any other object; however, sexual battery does not include an act done for a bona fide medical purpose.
  - (i) "Victim" means a person who has been the object of a sexual offense.
- (j) "Physically incapacitated" means bodily impaired or handicapped and substantially limited in ability to resist or flee.
- (2)(a) A person 18 years of age or older who commits sexual battery upon, or in an attempt to commit sexual battery injures the sexual organs of, a person less than 12 years of age commits a capital felony, punishable as provided in ss. <u>775.082</u> and <u>921.141</u>.
- (b) A person less than 18 years of age who commits sexual battery upon, or in an attempt to commit sexual battery injures the sexual organs of, a person less than 12 years of age commits a life felony, punishable as provided in s. <u>775.082</u>, s. <u>775.083</u>, s. <u>775.084</u>, or s. <u>794.0115</u>.
- (3) A person who commits sexual battery upon a person 12 years of age or older, without that person's consent, and in the process thereof uses or threatens to use a deadly weapon or uses actual physical force likely to cause serious personal injury commits a life felony, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, s. 775.084, or s. 794.0115.

- (4) A person who commits sexual battery upon a person 12 years of age or older without that person's consent, under any of the following circumstances, commits a felony of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. <u>775.082</u>, s. <u>775.083</u>, s. <u>775.084</u>, or s. <u>794.0115</u>:
  - (a) When the victim is physically helpless to resist.
- (b) When the offender coerces the victim to submit by threatening to use force or violence likely to cause serious personal injury on the victim, and the victim reasonably believes that the offender has the present ability to execute the threat.
- (c) When the offender coerces the victim to submit by threatening to retaliate against the victim, or any other person, and the victim reasonably believes that the offender has the ability to execute the threat in the future.
- (d) When the offender, without the prior knowledge or consent of the victim, administers or has knowledge of someone else administering to the victim any narcotic, anesthetic, or other intoxicating substance which mentally or physically incapacitates the victim.
- (e) When the victim is mentally defective and the offender has reason to believe this or has actual knowledge of this fact.
  - (f) When the victim is physically incapacitated.
- (g) When the offender is a law enforcement officer, correctional officer, or correctional probation officer as defined by s. 943.10(1), (2), (3), (6), (7), (8), or (9), who is certified under the provisions of s. 943.1395 or is an elected official exempt from such certification by virtue of s. 943.253, or any other person in a position of control or authority in a probation, community control, controlled release, detention, custodial, or similar setting, and such officer, official, or person is acting in such a manner as to lead the victim to reasonably believe that the offender is in a position of control or authority as an agent or employee of government.
- (5) A person who commits sexual battery upon a person 12 years of age or older, without that person's consent, and in the process thereof does not use physical force and violence likely to cause serious personal injury commits a felony of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. <u>775.082</u>, s. <u>775.083</u>, s. <u>775.084</u>, or s. <u>794.0115</u>.
- (6) The offense described in subsection (5) is included in any sexual battery offense charged under subsection (3) or subsection (4).
- (7) A person who is convicted of committing a sexual battery on or after October 1, 1992, is not eligible for basic gain-time under s. <u>944.275</u>. This subsection may be cited as the "Junny Rios-Martinez, Jr. Act of 1992."
- (8) Without regard to the willingness or consent of the victim, which is not a defense to prosecution under this subsection, a person who is in a position of familial or custodial authority to a person less than 18 years of age and who:
- (a) Solicits that person to engage in any act which would constitute sexual battery under paragraph (1)(h) commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. <u>775.082</u>, s. <u>775.083</u>, or s. <u>775.084</u>.
- (b) Engages in any act with that person while the person is 12 years of age or older but less than 18 years of age which constitutes sexual battery under paragraph (1)(h) commits a felony of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
- (c) Engages in any act with that person while the person is less than 12 years of age which constitutes sexual battery under paragraph (1)(h), or in an attempt to commit sexual battery injures the sexual organs of such person commits a capital or life felony, punishable pursuant to subsection (2).

- (9) For prosecution under paragraph (4)(g), acquiescence to a person reasonably believed by the victim to be in a position of authority or control does not constitute consent, and it is not a defense that the perpetrator was not actually in a position of control or authority if the circumstances were such as to lead the victim to reasonably believe that the person was in such a position.
- (10) Any person who falsely accuses any person listed in paragraph (4)(g) or other person in a position of control or authority as an agent or employee of government of violating paragraph (4)(g) is guilty of a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. <u>775.082</u>, s. <u>775.083</u>, or s. <u>775.084</u>. To be sure that the medication you were given prevented any STDs, you should visit your doctor in 2 to 6 weeks for follow up or sooner if you develop any symptoms. Your private physician, a medical clinic, or the Health Department can perform these tests. The choice of health care providers is yours, but it is very important that you take care of your body. For more information on medical care after a rape, please look at the After Sexual Assault pamphlets given to you by the rape crisis counselor.

Unlike gonorrhea, chlamydia or other minor infections, there is no treatment that will prevent or cure herpes or HIV/AIDS. There are treatments that can help to manage these STDs, so it is important to follow up with a physician and determine if you may have one of these treatable diseases. Herpes can be recognized by painful sores or blisters. If you develop these, it is best to see your physician. The risk of infection of HIV, the virus that causes AIDS, is low if there has only been one sexual encounter. However, a blood test is recommended. Until you get results from an HIV test, it may be best to practice safe sex. To protect your health and the health of your partner(s), always use condoms with spermicide from start to finish during sexual encounters.



#### **Essential Points to Consider**

#### I. Preservation of evidence

- 1. The sexual assault kit taken on 12/7/12 revealed:
  - a. Generalized vaginal tears;
  - b. Bruising on the back of the right arm;
  - c. Bruise on the left thigh;
  - d. Redness on the top of the right foot;
  - e. There was DNA and blood present in the victim's underwear;
  - f. Lower back muscle spasms.

This sexual assault kit was not submitted to FLDE until January 17, 2013, 39 days after it was taken, how is the evidence preserved during that lapse of time, who had access to it, and was it stored under proper conditions to preserve the evidence?

- 2. The toxicology samples were not submitted to FDLE until January 17, 2013.
- 3. Angulo needed to immediately go to Pot Belly's and take custody of all video surveillance from the night in question which may well have revealed the identity of the man who gave the victim the shot that preceded her amnesia as to receiving the text message from an unknown person, leaving the bar, how she ended up in a cab with three unknown males, etc.. Videos from bars are known to have short shelf life because they are taped over, usually in 7 days. This was time sensitive evidence the Det. Angulo failed to obtain.
- 4. Angulo needed to obtain a search warrant for Winston's apartment once he was identified to:
  - o Take samples of fluids in the bedroom and bathroom;

- Take custody of the sheets described by the victim;
- Take photos of the broken door, the bedroom and the bathroom;
- Take custody of the scooter used by the perpetrator to remove the victim from the scene.
- 5. Angulo needed to obtain search warrants for Casher's phone and text messages, the person to whom the victim gave her phone number, to determine if the text luring her out of the bar was from him.
- 6. Angulo needed to obtain search warrants for Darby's phone and text messages or Winston's phone and text messages.
- 7. Angulo needed to collect and test the Winston's DNA as soon as he was identified by victim on January 11, 2013, and submit same to FDLE for comparison.

#### II. Interview essential witnesses

- 1. Angulo needed to interview Chris Casher before informing Winston, his roommate, that he was a suspect;
- 2. Angulo needed to interview Darby, who Casher no doubt would have identified as being present;
- 3. Angulo needed to interview the outcry witness, Jenna Weisberg, the same person who notified police and accompanied the victim in the back of the squad car to the hospital.

- 4. Angulo needed to interview the nurse who performed the rape exam.
- 5. Angulo needed to interview Monique Kessler.
- 6. Angulo needed to interview Marcus Jordan.
- 7. Angulo needed to make a public statement seeking the cab driver who transported the victim and the suspect on December 7, 2012. His report states he sent an email out to the cab drivers, but there is no such email anywhere in the 248 pages which constitutes their "entire investigation".
- 8. Angulo needed to interview the security guard who Darby alleged he spoke to on the night in question.

### III. Opportunity to identify perpetrator on first day of investigation

1. Angulo could have identified the perpetrator on December 7, 2013, after taking the videoed statement of the victim wherein she made an identification of "Chris", the only freshman starter; he (Chris Casher) was an easy person to locate in Tallahassee as he was on the football time and they probably don't have a lot of freshman starters named Chris.
