Off Limits: **No Off Limits – Tournament Rules apply for the period between July 20-24 with regards to fishing and receiving information pertaining to the tournament waters.**

Tournament Waters: Tournament waters will be Lake Couchiching and Lake Simcoe and all rivers, creeks and canals connecting to Lake Couchiching and Lake Simcoe. Only that water open to **ALL** public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. **NO LOCKING.**

Fishing License: Non Resident Sport Fishing License - \$68.00 for Calendar year
Or 8 day Non-Resident Sport Fishing License - \$43.50. Non Resident Fishing Licenses are available through the mail by calling 1-800-667-1940. Please allow 4-6 weeks for delivery. (Local tackle shops sell Non-Resident Licenses on the spot as well) **DO NOT Purchase Non Resident Conservation License!**
