Owner and Gamakatsu hooks (2/0 and 4/0 wide gap models)	"The water is warming and the specks and bass will be spawning soon. We should be killing them from here on out."
Owner and VMC wide gap bait-holding hooks; Ice Gator electric augers	"The fishing's been the best in my lifetime for bass and perch."
Eagle Claw baitholder hooks (No. 8 and No. 10)	"It's been pretty good for yellow perch, trout and some bluegill."
Northland Tackle live bait rigs	"It's a slow time, but anglers are catching walleye, crappie and panfish through the ice."
