



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I register?

Visit www.Bassmaster.com/Marshals for the Bassmaster Elite Series Marshal Enrollment page. Priority online enrollment for BASS Insider, Federation Nation & Life members begins Tuesday, August 4, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. EST. Online registration begins for all BASS members on Tuesday, August 25, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. EST.

What do I need to know in order to be an effective Bassmaster Elite Series Marshal?

Prior to arriving to the tournament site, you need to be familiar with the competition rules. Once on site, you will be trained by a BASS official on how to use BASSCast and BASS Trak.

What is BASSCast?

BASSCast is an on-board camera developed by ESPN. The camera will be installed by BASS and the Marshal will be responsible for making minor adjustments and simple troubleshooting as needed.

What is BASS Trak?

BASS Trak is cell phone based scoring technology developed by ESPN. The BASS Trak mobile phone will be issued to you once you arrive on-site at the tournament location.

How much is the enrollment fee?

There is an enrollment fee of \$100 per event. Once on-site, you will experience at least two full days on the water with Bassmaster Elite Series Pro Anglers and an exclusive gift pack that includes an official Bassmaster Elite Series Marshal uniform.

Will I be on the water for 2 or 3 days?

All Marshals will be paired with a pro for the first two days of competition. The first 50 people to check "yes, I want to be a Marshal on Day 3" on the enrollment page will be eligible to participate on the 3rd competition day.

What if there are more than 50 people enrolled for Saturday? Can I still check "yes?"

Yes. We will have a waiting list for Saturday if we have more than 50 people signed up. The waiting list is first come, first served.

Will I be paired with the same Bassmaster Elite Series Pro each day?

Days one and two you should be paired with a different Elite Pro. If you sign up for day three there is a chance you could be paired with the same pro with whom you rode days one or two.

How do I know with whom I will be paired ?

Day 1 pairings will be announced during the mandatory briefing meeting held the day before the first competition day. Day 2 pairings will be posted in weigh-in area.

Where do I go once I'm on site?

Once you register to become a Bassmaster Marshal, you will receive an email containing an information sheet that will include the Marshal schedule.

Is the enrollment fee refundable?

Enrollment fees are only refundable to those who are not called from the waiting list, Marshals that are selected fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

What should I bring to the event?

Foul weather gear, your own Life Vest, sunscreen and lip balm. Each day you should bring sufficient drinks (no alcohol) and snacks. Also, bring any prescribed medication you may need.
